<i>Romania may not be the first place you think of when you are looking to buy a Pinot Noir but this has all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy note you would expect.</i>

<i>This Primitivo has a mouth-coating palate of dried prune, date and cherry, with notes of sweet spice and a lick of chocolate. Great structure from the good balance between the soft tannins and acidity.</i>

Rhône, France	
<i>Attractive red berry nose with hints of spice. Lovely fruit entry on the palate with plenty of red and black berry flavours, overlaid with a hint of spice. Soft supple tannins and a lift of acidity give the wine length and complexity.</i>	
<b>Dehesa de Gazania Rioja Gran Reserva</b> 	<b>£40.00</b>

<i>On the nose, aromas of sweet ripe fruit and delicate smoky notes. On the palate, flavours of cherry, plum and blackberries. Rich liquorice and well integrated oak follow for an elegant finish.</i>
